We are excited to share this Call for Vendors for our **Upcountry Vintage Spring Market 2024**, on Saturday, April 20th at the Lewis & Clark County Fairgrounds Exhibit & Entry Halls in Helena, Montana! As always, the focus of Upcountry Vintage Market is on offering the best in vintage goods to our avid and loyal customers: antique, vintage, primitives, salvage, repurposed, farm finds, retro style, etc.

Booth Space & Tables

Spaces are available in two sizes: approximately 10'x10' for \$110 per space and 10'x20' for \$200. Tables (8' rectangular) rent for \$12 each. Chairs are not provided. Each 10x10 space includes two name badges for market entry.

Market Date & Hours

Saturday, April 20th from 9 am - 4 pm. Entry is \$5; half price after 2 pm, 12 & under free. Show hours will be observed; no packing up until 4 pm. Vendor Setup is Friday, April 19th, 9 am - 6 pm.

We will be at the Lewis & Clark County Fairgrounds Exhibit & Entry Halls. This venue is a wonderful space for both our customers & vendors – plenty of access & parking, easy to find, plenty of space, large aisles, great lighting and amenities, etc.

Vendors agree to observe the above listed show hours by having at least one person always present at Vendor's booth during show hours.

USE OF PREMISES: No nails, screws, bolts or fastenings are allowed to be used on any part of the Exhibit Hall. No tape of any kind, except for painter's tape, is allowed to be used. No permanent markings, pens, markers, paint, etc. is allowed.

DAMAGES AND INDEMNIFICATION: Vendor is responsible for all damages caused by Vendor. Vendor agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold The Vintage Rose, LLC harmless for all claims resulting from Vendor's negligence. The Vintage Rose, LLC is not liable for any damage or injury that may occur to Vendor, Vendor's employees or agents, or Vendor's goods or equipment unless the damage or injury is the result of The Vintage Rose, LLC's own negligence.

ATTORNEYS' FEES: If any party to this Contract institutes any legal cause of action—including arbitration—against another party arising out of or relating to this Contract, the prevailing party will be entitled to the costs incurred in conducting the cause of action, including reasonable attorneys' fees and expenses and court costs.
